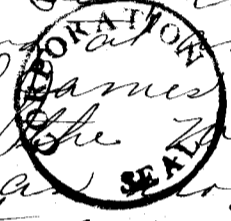

Any other certain day of said year, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate at the North-west intersection of James Street and David Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having according to a plat thereof prepared by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, dated February 12, 1931, the following lines and bounded courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the North-west intersection of James and David Streets, and running thence along the West side of David Street, N. 24° W. 127 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 58° 03' W. 72 feet 5 inches to an iron pin; thence S. 25° 20' E. 21 feet 9 inches to an iron pin on the North side of James Street; thence along the northern side of James Street, N. 61° 40' E. 69 feet, 9 inches to the point of beginning.
