WHEREAS, Mabel M. Attaway the said Mabel M. C. Cleveland property, made by W. C. Walter, Engineer, on March 14, 1926, said plat being recorded in the P. M. & office for Greenville County, in Plat Book B, and described by Metes and bounds, courses and distances, as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North side of Pomsett Avenue, joint corner of Lots Nos. 52 and 51, and running thence along said Avenue, S. 63° 01' E. 70 feet to corner of Lot No. 50; thence along line of last mentioned Lot, N. 26° 58' E. 164.3 feet to a stake; thence N. 84° 43' W. 75.1 feet to corner of Lot No. 52; thence along line of Lot No. 52, S. 26° 59' W. 164.3 feet to the beginning point on Pomsett Avenue.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to the Mortgagee herein by deed of J. Edgar B. Brown dated March 21, 1925, and recorded in the P. M. & office for Greenville County in Mortgage Volume 103, at page 77.

Privilege is given to make additional payments on account of the principal sum of said note on the first day of any month. Such payments shall be in multiples of the Monthly principal installment herein provided for.

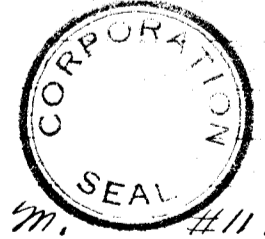
South Carolina Release
