TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, I, Gillie Mary Long the said Gillie Mary Long and Edwin Arthur Long SEND GREETING:

in and by our certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted unto THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA (a corporation duly chartered under the laws of the State of New Jersey and duly licensed to do business within the State of South Carolina, by the laws of said State) in the full and just principal sum of Five Thousand

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known as Lot no. 2 on plat of the property of W. S. Giffin et al., as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Book 31, at pages 178 and 179, and having, according to survey made by R. E. Dalton October 29, 1935, the following margins and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the West side of East North Street, at corner of Lot no. 2 on said plat, said pin being 140.7 feet North from the northwest corner of the intersection of a 40 foot unnamed street and East North Street, and running thence with the line of Lot no. 2 N. 77-03 W. 163.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N 20-41 E. 70.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot no. 4; thence with the line of said Lot no. 4, S. 77-03 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the West side of East North Street; thence with the West side of said Street, S. 12-57 W. 35 feet to an iron pin on said Street; thence still with the West side of said Street, S. 6-24 W. 35 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
