the said Fountain Inn Oil Mill & Fertilizer Company has made certain payments upon the notes and mortgages above referred to, reducing the amounts due thereon, and

Whereas, the Fountain Inn Oil Mill & Fertilizer Company desires to borrow from time to time, now and in the future, sums of money from the Buckeye Cotton Oil Company, not to exceed the total amount of the two mortgages above referred to to-wit: Twenty-nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$29,500.00) Dollars, and

Whereas, it is the intent and purpose of the Fountain Inn Oil & Fertilizer Company and the Buckeye Cotton Oil Company to enter into an agreement whereby the Buckeye Cotton Oil Company shall, at its option, extend credit at the present time and from time to time in the future, in a total amount not exceeding Twenty-nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$29,500.00) Dollars, and that any and all sums so borrowed shall be secured by mortgage of the property, real, personal and mixed described in the two mortgages above referred to,
