All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, containing Two (2) acres, more or less, lying on the South side of the Southern Railway, right of way near to and just East of the Town of Landrum, in the County of Spartanburg, in the State of South Carolina, and being composed of a certain lot containing One-half (1/2) acre, conveyed to the Finger Lumber Company by L. L. Tucker on February 13th. 1912, by deed recorded in R. M. C. office in Deed Book 51C. at Page 208, and the remaining portion of a certain tract containing Four and one-half (4 1/2) acres, deeded to the Finger Lumber Company by H. N. Finger, on February 7th. 1906, by deed recorded in R. M. C. office for Spartanburg County, in Deed Book 4-K at Page 375, the lot hereby conveyed being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Western margin of the Southern Railway right-of-way, 50 ft. from the center of the Main tract, running thence S. 60-35 W. 168.4 ft. across the Appalachian Highway to a point in the center of Finger St. near the water tank; thence to the Appalachian Highway, and with the same S 14-12 E. 415 ft to a point in the center of the Appalachian Highway; thence N. 56-44 E. 151.4 to a stake, thence S. 32.55 E. 91 ft. to a iron pin, thence N. 56.53 E. 147.5 ft. to a corner on the Western margin of the Southern Railway right-of-way 50 ft. from the center line of the main track, thence parallel to the center line of the Main track at a uniform distance of 50 ft. from the same to the point of beginning all of which will more fully appear from a plat made by W. N. Willis, C. E. November 10, 1919, and being the same lands conveyed to Inman Builders Supply Company, by H. N. Finger, as Receiver of the Finger Lumber Company, on the day of February 1924, by his deed duly recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Spartanburg County in Deed Book 6-I at Page 452.

All that lot, piece or parcel of land, lying, being and situate in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots no. 530-531 and 532 of Plat no. 8 of the property of the Tryon Development Company, known as Lake Lanier, made by George Kershaw, C. E., and duly recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book G.

Lot no. 530, having a frontage of 49.1 ft. a rear width of 22.4 ft. and side depths of 175.7 ft and 169 ft. lot no. 531 having a frontage of 44.7 ft a rear width of 44.7 ft and side depth of 175 ft. on each side, lot no. 532 having a frontage of 54.7 ft. a rear width of 54.7 ft. and a side depth of 175 ft. on each side, said measurements being based on road centers.
