Barksdale to the Union Trust Company of Maryland and American Bank and Trust Company, as Trustees, dated on the 15th day of August, 1926, and recorded in the office of the Register of mesne Conveyances, of Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 183, Page 25; the property thereby conveyed being described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot no. 62 on a plat of Alta Vista, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "G", page 20, and having, according to a survey made by Dalton and Neves, July 1926, the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on the South side of Oliver Street, at the intersection of Oliver Street and Apton Avenue, and running thence along the west side of Apton Avenue, S. 4-15 W. 200 feet to a point; thence N. 85-40 W. 62.5 feet to a point; thence N. 4-15 E. 200 feet to a point on the South side of Oliver Street; thence with said Street, S. 85-40 E. 62.5 feet to the point of beginning.

The Register of Deeds for Greenville County is hereby authorized and directed to satisfy Deed of Trust of record by endorsing such satisfaction upon the record of said Deed of Trust in Book no. 183, at page 25; of mortgages in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County, South Carolina.
