For value received, and without recourse on us in any event, we, the Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh, hereby transfer, sell and assign to the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, of Columbia, South Carolina, for itself and/or, as agent of the Land Bank Commissioner, and its successors and assigns, all our right title and interest in and to that certain and attached note and mortgage deed from W. V. Kirby to us, dated April 1, 1927, in the original sum of \$1,600.00 said mortgage being recorded in book 178 at page 44 in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, and covering one tract of land in Dunklin Township, said County and State.
