

For value received, and without recourse on us in any event, we, the Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh, hereby transfer, sell and assign to the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, of Columbia, South Carolina, for itself and/or as agent of the Land Bank Commissioner, and its successors and assigns, all our rights title and interest in and to that certain and attached note and mortgage deed from Henry Thomas Foster (unmarried) to us, dated March 12, 1927, in the original sum of \$1000.00 said mortgage being recorded in book 178 at page 40 in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, and covering one tract of land in O'Neal Township, said County and State.

In witness whereof, the said Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh has caused its name to be signed hereto by its Vice-President and attested by its Assistant Secretary, and its corporate seal affixed thereto, all by order of its Board of Directors, this ninth day of May 1934, and in the one hundred and fifty-eight year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
