

For Value Received, and without recourse on us in any event, we, the Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh, hereby transfer, sell and assign to the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, of Columbia, South Carolina, for itself and/or as agent of the Land Bank Commissioner, and its successors and assigns, all our right title and interest in and to that certain and attached note and mortgage deed from J. E. Morgan and Ella Victoria Morgan, his wife, to us, dated December 6, 1922 in the original sum of \$1,500.00, said mortgage being recorded in book 120 at page 123, in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, and covering one tract of land in O'Neal Township, said county and State.

In Witness Whereof, the said Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh has caused its name to be signed hereto by its Vice President and attested by its Assistant Secretary, and its corporate seal affixed thereto, all by order of its Board of Directors, this 24th day of August, 1934 and in the one hundred and fifty-eighth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
