Greer, to us, dated October 30, 1928, in the original sum of \$2,000.00. said mortgage being recorded in book 178 at Page 73 in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, and covering one tract of land in Chick Springs Township, said County and State.
