about 6 miles from Greenville Courthouse, on the old Augusta Road, known as tract No. 4 of the P. O. Chiles land, containing 10 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances; Beginning at an iron pin on Augusta Road, corner of tract No. 3, and running thence with old Augusta Road S. 3-45 E. 362 feet to bend; thence S. 8-30 E. 174 feet to iron pin, corner of other land of A. P. Meadors; thence with Meadors line N. 59 E. 1859 feet to stone, corner of said Meadors and Aug. W. Smith; thence S. 76 W. 1691 feet to point of beginning, being the same conveyed to A. P. Meadors by Julia D. Charles by deed dated January 30, 1929, recorded in book 142, page 25.
