all that tract or lot of land in Greenville, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning at an iron pin, 80 feet from the north-west corner of Monroe Street, and Hampton Avenue Extension and running thence along said Hampton Avenue Extension N. 40-40 W. 60 feet to pipe; thence N. 53 E. 108.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 51-44 E. 33 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 31-50 W. 32.1 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 50-00 E. 10 feet; thence S. 48-40 W. 85 feet to beginning.
