

On October 1, 1926 and payable to Robt L. Woodside and assigned by him to said Jennie B. McKay and Lilly L. McKay as collateral security for a note executed by John N. Woodside, Ed P. Woodside, J. Woodside or any of them until the said Woodside note and interest is paid in full, any balance remaining after payment of said Woodside note and interest is to be turned over to J. B. Ricketts as Trustee, he being the assignee and endorsee of Farmers Loan & Trust Company as to said notes, except as to the rights of the Misses McKay as above set out.
