ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE.

Knew all men by these presents, that I, Harriett K. Bellwood, of Greenville, S. C., for value received, have transferred, assigned and set over, and by these presents do hereby transfer, assign, and set over unto M. C. Eisenman, his heirs and assigns forever without recourse, that certain promissory note, dated November 12, 1924, for the sum of \$1500.00 given by O. B. Van Wyck to Marie G. Convers and T. C. Gower and assigned to Harriett K. Bellwood, to secure the indebtedness evidenced by said note, payable as follows, by extension agreement:

- \$500.00 of the principal one year after this date;
- \$500.00 of the principal two years after this date;
- \$500.00 of the principal three years after this date; and
- \$500.00 of the principal four years after this date,

together with the mortgage given to secure said indebtedness, which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 115, at page 190.

This paper is assigned as additional and collateral security to note of Julia D. Charles, dated December 17, 1919.

It is part of the agreement that said M. C. Eisenman and his assigns will carry these papers on for four years upon payment of the interest on the Four Thousand Dollar (\$4,000.00) note when it falls due, together with \$500.00 on the principal of said \$4,000.00 note on December 17, 1931; \$500.00 on the principal of said \$4,000.00 note on December 17, 1932, and \$500.00 on the principal of said \$4,000.00 note on December 17, 1933.

It is agreed between the mortgager and the mortgagee of the \$1500.00 paper that the entire principal debt remain unpaid, together with interest since July 28, 1928. Witness my hand and seal this the 23rd day of December 1930.
