


For value received, and the further sum of three dollars to me in hand paid, I do hereby assign, transfer and set over to Emily Treadwell, her heirs and assigns, forever, the mortgage in the sum of \$8655.51 (Eight Thousand Six hundred Fifty-Five and 51/100 Dollars) payable six months after date, with interest at 7% per annum, from June 1st, 1930, given to Annie L.
