Assignment

Whereas, heretofore, by order of the Court of Common Pleas of Greenville County, South Carolina, in the case of Julia Moore vs. Emily Ruth Moore, certain money belonging to the Minor defendant, Emily Ruth Moore, was placed in the hands of E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, authorizing him to invest for said Minor the Money in real estate mortgages, and that, pursuant to said order, the Master did invest a portion of the Money of the said Minor, Emily Ruth Moore, in the notes and mortgages hereinafter described; and,

Whereas, the said Emily Ruth Moore has now attained majority and it is no longer necessary for the Master to handle said mortgages for the Minor defendant, the Master is desirous of transferring and assigning the said notes and mortgages hereinafter described to Emily Ruth Moore;

Now, I therefore, in consideration of the premises, I, E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, South Carolina, do hereby assign, transfer and set over to Emily Ruth Moore the following notes and mortgages, to-wit:

(3) Note of Mrs. Addie M. Cox to E. Inman, Master, for \$100.00, dated November 11, 1925, secured by mortgage of even date recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 155, at page 478.

(4) Note of Mrs. Addie M. Cox to E. Inman, Master, for \$350.00, dated December 11, 1925, secured by mortgage of even date recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 155, at page 498.

(5) Note of Mrs. Addie M. Cox to E. Inman, Master, for \$200.00, dated March 10, 1926, secured by mortgage of even date recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 155, at page 564.
