All that certain piece or parcel of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of Curton Street, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the city of Greenville, and having, according to survey made by Dalton & Necker, July, 1926, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Curton Street, which iron pin is 572 feet East of Augusta Road, and running thence N. 31-44 W. 173.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 63-42 E. 77.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 26-51 E. 167 feet to an iron pin on Curton Street; thence along said Street S. 58-19 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
