M. C. of Greenville County, South Carolina, on the 14th day of October, 1929, in the book 183, at Page 181; the property thereby conveyed being described as follows:

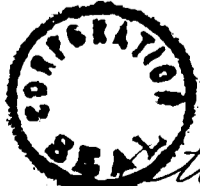
All that certain lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County of Greenville near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville on the West side of Underwood Ave. and being known and designated as Lot # 48 in Green Grove Park, as shown on Plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "7" page 233, and having according to survey made by C. M. Furman Jr., engineer, September, 1925, the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Underwood Avenue, being 272.8 feet North of Monticello Avenue and running thence with Underwood Avenue N. 15° 48' E. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner lot # 49; thence with line of that lot N. 74° 12' W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 15° 48' W. 50 feet to an iron pin corner of lot # 47; thence with the line of that lot S. 74° 12' E. 150 feet to the point of beginning.

The Register of Deeds for Greenville County is hereby authorized and directed to satisfy the deed of trust of record by endorsing such satisfaction upon the record of said deed of trust in Book No. 183, at Page 181 of Mortgages in the office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County South Carolina.
