in the full and just sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) and well as  
Dollars, to be paid One year from date day of April

with interest thereon, from date Paid in full this 13th day of April  
annually at the rate of 8% per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing of an attorney's fee of ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Rosa L. West

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said W. C. Henson and his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated  
lying on waters of South Tyger River, near Cheaf in  
Cheaf Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina  
containing thirty-four (34) acres more or less, and bounded  
by the lands of Jerry Smith, J. J. Paris and  
others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by  
deed of Mrs Fannie Gray on April 26th, 1922, as recorded  
in Deed Book 62 at page 72, less 52 acres conveyed to me  
by J. W. West by deed recorded in Deed Book 98 at page 577
