Dollars, to be paid *November 1, 1930*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *4%* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing of an attorney's fee of *ten per cent. of amount due*
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I* the said *Robert Wilson*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *H. St. Townes*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *H. St. Townes, Attorney*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *H. St. Townes, Attorney, his heirs and assigns*

all those two certain lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and described as follows:
Lot No 1: all that piece, parcel and tract of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about three miles from Greenville Court House, near the settlement known as Greentown, and having the following meters and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning in a road at corner of lot conveyed by me Robert Wilson, to Major Heyward, and running thence with said lot, S. 13-30 E. 234 feet to an iron pin in road, corner of Cyclone Starter and Truck Company's land, running thence with said Cyclone Starter and Truck Company's land, S. 76-30 W. 417.8 feet to an iron pin, corner of Cyclone Starter and Truck Company's land and Cemetery lot; thence with Cemetery lot, N. 13-30 W. 234 feet to an iron pin, corner of Major Heyward's lot; thence with Major Heyward's lot, N. 76-30 E. 417.8 feet, to the beginning corner, being part of the land conveyed to me, said Robert Wilson, by Bessie Edens, by deed recorded in the R.M.C.
