All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, near Beaverdam Creek of Enoree River, eleven Miles from Greenville, S. C. in O'Neal Township; containing one hundred (100) acres, more or less; and with such marks, bounds as follows, viz; Beginning on a stone at bridge on Mucklehoney Road, thence S. 77 1/2 E. 45. 75 to a stone near Beaverdam Creek; thence East 7. 20 to a stake; thence S. 81 E. 7. 20 to a stone near a large natural rock; thence S. 77 E. 15. 15 to stone; thence N. 52 1/3 W. 38. 90 to a R.
