TO WHOM ALL THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Whereas,

in and by John Lee, certain John Lee, note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to Greenville County School District No. 17A, in the full and just sum of Eighty-four Dollars (\$84.00), to be paid to John Lee, to be paid three (3) years after date, at the Messville to Anticipate, paying date, five percent (5%) per annum, and any interest with interest thereon from May 5th next until paid, at the Messville to Anticipate, at the rate of 10 centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, and before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Greenville County School District No. 17A, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration to the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00), the said John Lee, in hand, well and truly paid by the said John Lee, at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville County School District No. 17A in Greenville County,

all that certain tract of land, situated in Greenville County, Oaklawn Township, State of South Carolina, Mountain Tract No. 2, in the partition of land of Jasper Wilson, deceased, the metes and bounds of which, appear on plat of survey of said lands made by William P. Lee, Surveyor, on the 14th and 16th days of October, 1913, and same follows:

Beginning at a rock 13, common corner of tracts nos. 1, 2 and 3, and running thence N. 41° 42' 30.50 to a rock & then e. 47 1/4° 21'. 18.36 to rock x3, thence S. 74 1/2° E. 15.00 to a rock, x3 on road, thence S. 24° 34' E. 6.08 to rock x3, then e. S. 5 1/2° E. 16.52 to rock x3, the beginning corner, containing 3 1/2 acres, more or less. Being the same lot of land conveyed, to me by J. H. Gray Master forf. Greenville County, fordeed; dated November 3d, 1913, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for said county, in volume 14, at page 153.

Also all that certain tract of land situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Oaklawn Township, one mile east of Elzer, near the Holland Ford Road and bounded by lands of P. M. Scott, W. B. Beam and H. P. Beam same being a part of tract known as tract no. 1 on a plat of the survey of lands of Jasper Wilson deceased, by Wm. P. Lee, Surveyor, on October 14th, 1913, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron stake 37, d. 42 E. 25.50 to stone 3cm. thence N. 44° E. 7.75 to stone 3cm., thence N. 37° 21'. 23.68 to iron stake 3cm.; thence S. 55° 21'. 11.60 to beginning corner, iron stake 3in. containing 26.6 acres, more or less. Being the same land conveyed to me by W. P. Beam, fordeed; dated April 18th, 1918, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for said county, in volume 25, at page 132.
