at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to
become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should
be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection
of his interests to place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either

of land situate and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South
Carolina, on the South side of Pettigru Street, and being a portion of Lot No. 2, of
Block 5, as shown on plat of Bovee Addition, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office
for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Pettigru Street, which pin is 73-1/3
feet East of the corner of Toy Street, and running thence S. 15-00 E. parallel with and 6
feet, 8 inches from the line of Lot No. 1, 126, feet, 1 inch to an iron pin on a ten foot
