

# The State of South Carolina,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Dakyns B. Stover  
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Dakyns B. Stover  
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 27th day of May 1930

am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 27th day of May A. D. 1930  
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I

the said Dakyns B. Stover shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly on the 20th or before the end of the month of June 1930, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of 33/100 (\$3.33)

Dollars, (4.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the four Shares of Stock and Five Dollars (\$33/100 (\$2.33)) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five Dollars, (5.87) Dollars, (5.87) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One Dollar, (1.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Five Dollars, (5.40) Dollars, (4.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One Dollar, (1.40) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Four Dollars, (4.93) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and Four Dollars, (4.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Four Dollars, (4.47) Dollars, (4.47) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and Four Dollars, (4.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) (Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said me shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said Dakyns B. Stover and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said Dakyns B. Stover in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the conditions hereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said Dakyns B. Stover in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Dakyns B. Stover in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Row, Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as Lot No. 2, according to plat of same recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 34, Page 124, reference being made to said plat for a more complete description. Said lot has a frontage of 30 feet and runs back for a depth of 91.5 feet, and is the same lot conveyed to Dakyns B. Stover by J. Heyward Curton, May 16, 1930, by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book — Page —.
