I, Anna Gossett
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Anna Gossett
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 21st day of October 19 32

am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 21st day of October A. D. 19 32

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I the said Anna Gossett shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of November 19 32, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Ten + 20¢ (\$10.00) Dollars, (6.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the

six Shares of Stock and Four + 20¢ (\$4.00) Dollars,

being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Nine + 20¢ (\$9.20) Dollars, (6.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three + 20¢ (\$3.20) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Five + 40¢ (\$5.40) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Eight + 40¢ (\$8.40) Dollars,

(6.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two + 40¢ (\$2.40) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seven + 60¢ (\$7.60) Dollars, (6.00 Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and

One + 60¢ (\$1.60) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Six + 80¢ (\$6.80) Dollars, (6.00 Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and

six Shares of Stock and the certificate thereof, the amount of which time paid shall be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said Anna Gossett

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said Anna Gossett in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Anna Gossett in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Anna Gossett

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that tract of land, about three and one-half miles from Greenville Court House, on the south side of White Horse Road, being my home place, containing about six and one-half acres, composed of two tracts, tract containing about five and 35¢ (5.35) acres, described in deed of B. S. Freeman and Julia Freeman to Anna Gossett, dated January 27, 1916, and recorded in Deed Book 38, page 521, and a one-acre tract conveyed to Anna Gossett by Alice E. Means, deed dated May 30, 1916, recorded in Deed Book 39, page 374, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. The above tracts are bounded by lands of B. S. Freeman, Julia Freeman, Southern Railroad, and White Horse Road.
