This 25<sup>th</sup> with interest thereon, from April 1st, 1930, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be

computed and paid Bi-monthly

and paid in full all interest unpaid which due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Beginning at an iron pin on Conestee Avenue S. 27-15 W. 60 feet from the intersection of Conestee Avenue and Eleie Avenue and running thence N. 62-45 W. 172 feet to a stake at corner of lot #34; thence along a 15 foot alley S. 27-15 W. 60 feet to a stake at corner of lot number 36; thence S. 62-45 E. 172 feet to an iron pin on Conestee Avenue; thence along Conestee Avenue N. 27-15 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to me by South Atlantic Investment Corporation by deed dated April 24, 1930 and not yet recorded.
