I, **P. A. Green,**

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, **I**, the said **P. A. Green,**
in and by **my** certain **promissory** note in writing, of
even date with these presents, **am** well and truly indebted to

Dr. J. A. Thomason,

in the full and just sum of **One Thousand Dollars,**
~~more~~ to be paid **on or by the 24th day of July 1931**

with interest thereon from **the 27th day of July 1931** date **at** the rate of **eight** per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid **semi-annually**

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
re thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will
more fully appear.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, That **I** the said **P. A. Green,**
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Dr. J. A. Thomason,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to **me**, the said

P. A. Green,

in hand well and truly paid by the said **Dr. J. A. Thomason,**

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said **Dr. J. A. Thomason, his heirs and assigns:**

**All that certain, piece, parcel or lot of land, lying being and situate in the
County and State aforesaid and in the town of Fountain Inn, with the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:**

**Beginning at a point on the Jones Mill Road Street, corner of W. T. Jones,
running thence with Jones Mill Road Street in an Easterly direction 200 feet to a point
in Thackston Street; thence along Thackston Street, South 285 feet to a point, corner of
my own land; thence along line of my land in a Westerly direction 100 feet to a point,
corner of W. T. Jones; thence in a Northerly direction along line of W. T. Jones 218 feet
to the beginning corner, on Jones Mill Road Street and containing one acre more or less;
this being the same lot of land upon which my present residence is situated and being a
portion of the four and 54/100 acres tract of land conveyed to me by deed of W. P. Meadors
by his deed dated February 3, 1920 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Deed Book 57 at page 520. Bounded by Jones Mill Road Street, Thackston Street,
