SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, *H. F. Gaylord*, the said *H. F. Gaylord*
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

H. N. Gaylord
in the full and just sum of *Three Hundred Twenty five (\$325.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *December 15th, 1931*

with interest thereon, from *after maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
reue thercon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, *H. F. Gaylord*, the said *H. F. Gaylord*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

H. N. Gaylord
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to

H. F. Gaylord
in hand well and truly paid by the said

H. N. Gaylord,
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said *H. N. Gaylord, his heirs and assigns forever.*

*All of my 1/8th undivided interest in all of that certain
piece, parcel and tract of land being and lying in
the State and County aforesaid, containing 112 acres, more
or less (this 1/8th interest being 6 2/3 acres) and known as
the H. F. Gaylord Estate, upon which I reside and bounded
by lands of W. R. Satterfield, D. G. Mayfield, G. J. L. Hughes
and B. A. Shackleton.*

*This 1/8th (6 2/3 acres) undivided interest being the same
interest deeded to me by Norman Clark, December 3rd,
1917, witnessed by R. R. Cooper and J. A. Marlar and not
yet recorded, said deed to be recorded at the same time
this mortgage is to be recorded.*

*The 1/8th (or 6 2/3 acres) has no other mortgage over it
and the same is not yet mentioned in any other mort-
gage that I have given, this is in addition to the 1/2
interest that I also own in the entire Estate.*
