in the full and just sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars
Dollars, to be paid One year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid Semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Seven per cent of above amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as we
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Jessie Dickerson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said J. D. Aiken, his heirs and assigns:

All that tract of land in Paris Mountain Town-
ship, County and State aforesaid, known as part of
the land conveyed to J. B. Thompson by deed from
J. W. Gray, Master, and a part of Lot No. 12 in the
division of Gabe Thompson estate, adjoining lands
of J. B. Thompson, and William Thompson, and others
beginning on an iron pin on the white Horse
Road; thence running N. 34 W. 110 to fork of road; thence
with Tinley Bridge Road, N. 55 W. 8.25 to stake; thence
S 51 3/4 W. 12.00 to a stake on branch; thence up said
branch to stake on branch; thence N. 51 3/4 E. 12.00 to
the beginning corner. And containing 10 1/4 acres, more
or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed
