SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the said *Oregon Lumber Company, a corporation*

is and by *it* certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents *is* well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation, incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of

Sixteen hundred no/100 Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the *40th* Series of the Instalment Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full;

and if *it* fails to pay said interest or comply in all respects with the By-Laws of said Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hand of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as provided in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

a corporation in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *it*, the said

Oregon Lumber Company, a corporation, in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Greenville County, South Carolina,

about 2 1/2 miles west of Greenville courthouse, being a part of lot no. 1-3 of West Highland as shown on plat recorded in plat book 6, page 257-259, and having the following courses and distances: Beginning at a stake on the east side of Georgia Avenue, 205 feet south of the intersection of Georgia Avenue and Casley Bridge Road, and running thence parallel with Casley Bridge Road N. 71 E. approximately 167.8 feet to right of way of P. & N. Railroad. thence with said right of way S. 11 E. 56 feet to stake, corner of lot now or formerly of W. T. Cooper; thence with Cooper line S. 71 W. 33 feet to stake; thence S. 11 E. 44 feet to stake; thence S. 71 W. 133.3 feet to stake in Georgia Avenue, and thence with Georgia Avenue N. 9-30 W. 100 feet to beginning.
