Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County in the State aforesaid, as follows, to wit:

*in or near the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on Whitehall Street, Stone's line, and running thence with said Whitehall Street N. 27-10 E. 50 feet to a stake, Gresham's corner; thence with Gresham's line N. 31-55 W. 79 feet, more or less, to a stake; thence S. 28-48 W. 45 feet to a stake, Stone's line. thence with Stone's line S. 79-30 E. 108 feet, more or less to the beginning corner, being all of the lot of land between Stone's line and Gresham's line.
