County and State aforesaid, containing fifty-two (52) acres,
more or less and being a portion of the lands formerly
owned by J. J. Campbell and now owned jointly by myself
and Mrs. Maggie Ridgeway, the said tract of land lying
about one mile west of Old Hundred School House on
the road leading toward Pelzer.
