NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said **W. F. Green,**

.....in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **W. H. McCauley,**

all that tract or lot of land in **Greenville** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In Park Place, known as lot No. 4, Block I, as shown on plat of said subdivision recorded in plat book A, page 119, said lot being on Second Avenue, being the same conveyed to me by J. P. Shaw by deed dated February 11, 1931, recorded in book 114, page 446.

Also that tract of land in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 20 acres, more or less, as shown by survey of W. A. Hester October 1920, and September 1929, on the east side of Rutherford Road, adjoining Q. A. Green, T. R. Green, and Jeff C. Hawkins, being all that remains of a tract of 28 1/2 acres, conveyed to me by T. Reid Green, April 30, 1921, deed recorded in book 71, page 465, after the conveyance by me of 8.09 acres to Jeff C.
