Dollars, to be paid One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars one year from date and One Hundred
(\$100.00) Dollars two (2) years from date.

with interest thereon, from date annually at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid.

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

gain, sell and release unto the said W. T. Newby, his heirs and assigns.

County, South Carolina, bounded by lands of A. J. Bates, Ellen Montgomery and others,
containing five (5) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds,
to wit: Beginning on a stone on road and running thence S. 50 1/2 E. 10.00 to W. 0.;
thence N. 46 1/4 E. 4.80 to a stake; thence S. 51 1/4 W. 10.00 to stone; thence S. 49 W.
1.85 to the beginning corner.
