THIS INDENTURE, made the 7th day of July, 1931, in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, between Shepard Saltzman

and THE EQUITABLE LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY OF THE UNITED STATES, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, having its principal office in the Borough of Manhattan, of the City of New York, party of the second part; the said party of the first part being hereinafter known and designated as the MORTGAGOR, and the said party of the second part being hereinafter known and designated as the MORTGAGEE;

WITNESSETH: WHEREAS, the said mortgagee has issued to Shepard Saltzman

its certain policy of insurance, bearing register date the first day of June, 1931 and numbered 479,475, agreeing to pay to the beneficiary therein named upon receipt of due proof of the death of the insured, provided premiums have been duly paid and said policy be then in force and be then surrendered properly released, the sum of Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) DOLLARS, all in accordance with the terms and conditions of said policy.

WHEREAS, the said mortgagor is justly indebted to the said mortgagee in the sum of Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) DOLLARS, gold coin of the United States of America, of the present standard of weight and fineness, secured to be paid, together with the premiums on said policy of insurance, by a certain bond or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for the payment thereof at the principal office of the said mortgagee in the City of New York in One Hundred and Sixty-Five Dollars (\$165.00) regular equal monthly instalments, each of the sum of Sixty-Two Dollars (\$62.00) DOLLARS, gold coin as aforesaid, payable in advance on the first day of each successive calendar month beginning on the first day of July, 1931; and each instalment, except the first, which does not include interest, including:

(a) A payment on account of the principal of said loan;

(b) Interest at the rate of six per centum per annum, duly discounted, on the monthly decreasing balance of said principal sum which will remain unpaid on said loan after the payment of each of the said monthly instalments; and

(c) The monthly premium on said policy of life insurance.

And until the date on which the regular monthly instalments begin to be payable conditioned further for the payment of the interest on said principal sum and the monthly premiums on said policy of life insurance in thirty-five monthly instalments of \$... each commencing on the first day of July, 1931, and one month's interest in the sum of \$... on the first day of July, 1931, with the first regular monthly instalment which does not include interest.

It being in said bond expressly agreed that the whole of said principal sum, or the balance thereof from time to time outstanding, shall become due after default in the payment of any one of said instalments, or of the taxes, assessments or water rates, as therein provided, anything therein to the contrary notwithstanding.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, that the mortgagor, for the better securing the payment to the said mortgagee of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the bond or obligation as aforesaid, with interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the mortgagor, in hand paid by the mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece of land or parcel of land situated, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, first being and designated as Lot No. 94 of the North Hill subdivision as shown on plat of property of First Guaranty Trust Company, recorded in the R.M. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "H", at page 138, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of N^e Donald Street, 460 feet in a northerly direction from Sullivan Avenue, the joint corner of Lots Nos. 93 and 94, and running thence N. 66-28 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 23-32 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, the rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 94 and 95; thence with the joint line of said lots S. 66-28 E. 180 feet to an iron pin on the west side of N^e Donald Street; thence with the line of said Street, S. 23-32 W. 70 feet to the point of beginning.
