at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

H. J. Woodson, his heirs and assigns forever:
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Durkline
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, con-
taining forty two (42) acres, more or less, and being described
as follows:

Beginning on a stone 3X with P. Darwins "Cape Place",
thence N. 9 E. 26. 95 chains to stone 3X, formerly M. C. on East
bank of Cedar Shoals Creek, thence N. 2 1/2 W. 3. 15 chains to
stone 3X with H. A. Norwood, thence N. 51 W. 16. 60 chains to
stone 3X, thence S. 3 W. 36. 34 chains to stone 3X, thence S. 75 3/4
E. 11 chains to the beginning, bounded by lands now or
formerly of P. Darwins, H. A. Norwood and G. H. Acker.

This is the same land conveyed to Wm. F. Acker by
E. H. Acker by deed dated and recorded April 15th, 1902, in
