

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 197180

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Charles E. Davenport

to
The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a Mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated December 8th, 1936, recorded in said County on December 11th, 1936 in Volume of Book 171 on Page 42, the sum of Fifty Hundred and 10/100 Dollars, with interest from December 15th, 1931, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Charles E. Davenport

subject to said Mortgage, and,
WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said Charles E. Davenport

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: The principal sum of Fifty Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars being payable in annual installments of \$100.00, beginning on the fifteenth day of December, 1932, and on the same day in each succeeding year, thereafter, the sum of \$75.00, and the balance of said principal sum being payable on the fifteenth day of December, 1936

with interest thereon from December 15th, 1931, to December 15th, 1936, at the rate of Six per cent. per annum, payable annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments of \$100.00 or any multiple thereof of the principal sum of said note on any interest maturity date, and the amounts so paid shall be credited)

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said Mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and Mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
