

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 207497

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by J. J. West

to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a Mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County,

South Carolina, dated March 15, 1927, recorded in said County on March 15, 1927, in Volume 172 of Mortgages on Page 33, the sum of Twelve Thousand + 70/100 Dollars, with interest from March 15, 1927, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in J. J. West

subject to said Mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said J. J. West

hereby agree, \$ to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: \$300.00 on March 15, 1933; \$300.00 on September 15, 1933; \$300.00 on March 15, 1934; \$300.00 on September 15, 1934; \$300.00 on March 15, 1935; \$300.00 on September 15, 1935; \$300.00 on March 15, 1936; \$300.00 on September 15, 1936; \$600.00 on March 15, 1937;

with interest thereon from March 15, 1932 to March 15, 1937 at the rate of five and one-half per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of the note in sums of \$100.00 or multiples thereof on any interest maturity date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said Mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and Mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
