

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 2762

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by

W. Linway Wilson

to The Jefferson Standard Life Insurance Company The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage deed upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated November 10, 1921, recorded in said County on November 30, 1921, in Volume 68 of Mortgage Deeds on Page 88, the sum of Seventy-Five Hundred and Sixty-Six Dollars, with interest from May 10, 1932, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Robert S. Woodside

subject to said mortgage deed, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided, its consent being evidenced by its execution of this agreement. NOW, THEREFORE, The said Robert S. Woodside

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

\$234.00 November 10, 1932, \$234.00 May 10, 1933, \$234.00 November 10, 1933, and \$234.00 on the 10th of each and every May and November thereafter until November 10, 1941, at which time the unpaid balance shall become due and payable.

with interest thereon from May 10, 1932, to November 10, 1942, at the rate of eight (8%) per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said Mortgage Deed shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and Mortgage Deed and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
