

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 213461

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Barbara W. Campbell

The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County,

South Carolina, dated June 30, 1927, recorded in said County on June 30, 1927,
in Volume 172 of mortgages on Page 60, the sum of Five Thousand
(5,000.00) Dollars, with interest from June 30, 1922, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Barbara W. Campbell

subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said Barbara W. Campbell and G. P. Campbell
(husband)

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: Five Thousand (\$5,000.00)
Dollars on June 30, 1937,

with interest thereon from June 30, 1922 to June 30, 1937, at the rate of five and one-half
payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on
the principal sum of said note in sums of One
Hundred \$100.00 Dollars, or multiples thereof, on any
interest maturity date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage
shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force
except as herein modified.
