

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 255154-1

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by A. L. Lewis

to

The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated January 3rd, 1934, recorded in said County on January 4th, 1934, in Volume 171 of Mortgages on Page 58, the sum of Thirty-six Hundred (\$3600.00) Dollars, with interest from January 3rd, 1934, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in A. L. Lewis

subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said A. L. Lewis

hereby agrees to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: The sum of \$50.00 on the 3rd day of April 1934 and quarterly payments of \$50.00 on the 3rd day of each and every July, October, January and April during the life of this agreement, and the balance of the principal on January 3rd, 1939

with interest thereon from January 3rd, 1934, to January 3rd, 1939, at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, payable quarterly, annually, and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of this note in sums of (\$100.00) or multiples thereof, on any interest maturity date

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
