Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State aforesaid,

having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin corner of Brooks Avenue, and College Street, running thence S. 67 E. 72½ feet on College Street to an iron pin, corner of Methodist District Parsonage; thence S. with said lot or line to an iron pin, to corner of said District Parsonage lot, and on line of Mrs. F. M. Owens lot; thence N. with Mrs. F. M. Owens line 82½ feet to an iron pin on Brooks Avenue, thence N. 28 E. 107 feet to the beginning corner on College Street, with Brooks Avenue.
