WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Thirteen Hundred (\$1300.00)

money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville Township, and being a part of a lot known and designated as Lot NO. 9 of the sub-division known as Augusta Circle, as shown by a plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F", at page 23, and having the following metes and bounds:-

Beginning at a point on Augusta Drive fifty feet from the corner of Augusta Drive and Paris Road, and running S. 55-15 E. 50 feet to corner of lots Nos. 9 and 10, as shown by said plat, thence with line of lot No. 10, N. 20-16 E. 160 feet to line of lot No. 7; thence with line of lots Nos. 7 and 8, N. 55-15 W. 50 feet to a point on lot No. 8, 50 feet from the Paris Road; thence S. 20-16 W. 160 feet to the beginning corner, and being the Eastern half of lot No. 9, as shown on plat mentioned above, this being the same lot of land conveyed to the mortgagor as Martha Peace Knight, by Olive A. Peace by deed dated September 2nd, 1925, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 107, page 32.
