sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S.C.
all that tract or lot of land in Dick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

And containing 40 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin at the southeast corner of said 40 acre tract and running thence N. 76 degrees W. 32.03 chs to stone 4mm; thence 17.4 degrees E. 8.96 chs. to concrete corner; thence S. 86 3/4 degrees E. 33.44 chs. to stone; thence S 29 3/4 degrees E. 2.90 chs. to iron pin; thence S 14 1/2 Degrees E. 5.22 chs. to iron pin in road; thence S. 42 degrees W. 7.68 chs. to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of Sarah Rainey, J.
