all that tract or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All these two parcels of land in the County and State aforsaid, together containing 585 acres, more or less, and being described as follows:

- 1. All that tract containing 488 acres, more or less, being all that tract conveyed to me by Paul C. Cox by his deed dated July 24, 1907 and recorded in W. M. C. office for County and State aforsaid in Book 588, page 392;
2. Also all that tract of land containing 487 acres, more or less, in County and State aforsaid, being parts of several tracts conveyed to me by deed of Mary H. Cleveland and M. M. C. Harris by deed dated Feb. 1, 1899 and recorded in office of W. M. C. for County and State aforsaid in Book 777, page 592; this 487 acres, more or less, is made up of the following tracts and parts of tracts, all of which are clearly set forth on plat of Wm. A. Hudson D. V. from survey October 31, 1891 being plat of 812 acres, more or less, the same described in the Cleveland and Harris deed, which plat is delivered herewith to be recorded, and the tracts on said plat covered by this mortgage being as follows;

- (1) Tract #11, containing 9.8 acres, more or less;
(2) Tract #12, containing 70 acres, more or less;
(3) Tract #13, containing 60 acres, more or less;
(4) Tract #14, containing 3 1/2 acres, more or less;
