all that tract or lot of land in **Greenville** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the Old Rutherford Road, containing 3 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds; Beginning at an iron pin on the Old Rutherford Road and running thence N. 0-23 W. 245.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 80-23 W. 310 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 54-29 W. 207 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 28-08 E. 306.5 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the Rutherford Road; thence N. 67-07 E. 82.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 76-07 E. 265 feet to the beginning corner.

The above three acres of land have been subdivided into plots for cemetery purposes, and the mortgagee agrees to release from the lien of this mortgage any plot in the cemetery upon the payment of ten dollars, or any single grave upon the payment of two dollars, and any amounts so paid shall be credited or applied on the monthly payment for the current month.
