NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money

aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,

sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John D. Smith, TrusteeAll these two pieces, or parcels of land lying in
all that tract or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, as follows:

1st Tract: Beginning 60 yards above Johnson Old Mill Shoal on the west side of Fall Creek at High water mark; thence up said creek, to the top of shoals; thence across said Creek N.E. to a stake; thence a straight line to the old ford on Gap Creek; thence straight line to the beginning, containing two (2) acres, more or less.

2nd Tract: Beginning in the fork of Fall and Gap Creeks thence up Gap Creek to the old ford to the 34 of tract No. 1; thence W. with said line to the 34 on Fall Creek; thence down Fall Creek to the beginning; containing three (3) acres, more or less. Both tracts lying in forks of Gap Creek and Fall Creek branch waters of Middle Saluda River; adjoining lands of M.E. Smith and E. J. Reynolds.

Also a certain strip of right of way fifty (50) feet wide, beginning at a point 30 ft. up Gap Creek from the intersection of Fall and Gap Creeks and extending across said Gap Creek to the new highway.
