Jenkins*,in the full and just sum of *Five Hundred Dollars*, to be paid *on or before June 1st, 1932* Dollarsto be paid *six months after last payment*, *on or before June 1st, 1933* Dollarswith interest thereon from *July 1st, 1931*,at the rate of *6* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly* until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *One percent of amount collected* besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That *J. Jenkins, do hereby grant, sell, and release two tracts of land containing six and three-fourths (6 3/4) acres, more or less, and improve - three (3) acre - *lot* and *lot*, respectively, situated in *Greenville County, State of South Carolina*, and bounded up and down by the same two lots as tract of land conveyed to me by *Hill Fowler* by deed dated *June 1st, 1904* and recorded in office of *Prob. W. C. for Greenville County* in *Vol. 4, set page 128*, which has *1904*, fully described in accordance of said two lots and reference is made to documents made to said deed.*
