All that piece, parcel or lot of land known and designated as lot No. 66 of East Lake property according to a Blue print made by Dalton & Neves, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. O. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 93 at page 229, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in West Circle Avenue, the corner of lots 65 and 66, so running thence along West Circle Avenue, S. 37-20 E. sixty (60) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 52-40 W. one hundred eighty two and seven-tenths (182.7) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 37-20 W. sixty (60) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-40 E. one hundred eighty two and seven-tenths (182.7) feet to the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to L.
