at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

C. A. Tatterfield, his heirs and assigns:
All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County and State of S. C., on the Anderson Road, two and three-fourths (2 3/4) Miles from Greenville, S. C. containing eight and one-half (8 1/2) acres, more or less. Has such Mark and bounds as follows:
Beginning on a stake at the ford of the Branch of Moushy Creek; thence along the Meanders of the Run to a stone formerly a Black Run; thence N. 71 1/2 E. 7. 90 to a stake; thence N. 25 W. 13. 08 to a stake on said Anderson Road; thence along same S. 44 1/4 W. 6. 50 to a B.
